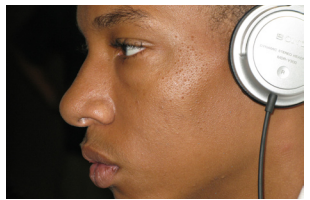
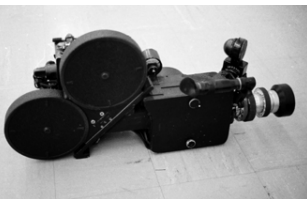

Frequently Asked Questions + answers.

what is On Our Side? On Our Side is a six-week summer program for youth ages 12-16. During the program, participants learn all aspects of documentary filmmaking from professional filmmakers. Our students plan and execute their own documentary film projects; we send them home with the Maysles Institute's cameras and equipment so that they can document their lives and tell their stories through film. As a grand finale, we invite the students' friends and families to an official screening of the finished projects in our cinema.

when does it happen? tuesdays and thursdays from 10-4, optional open studio fridays 10-4, from July 6th-August 21st.

where is the Maysles Institute? 343 Lenox Avenue, between 127th and 128th street, Harlem NYC, 10027

is transportation provided? NO. Parents or designated guardians are responsible for transporting participants to the Maysles Institute at 10am and retrieving them again at 4pm. The instructors will transport participants to events and field trips during the day.

is lunch provided? YES. The Maysles Institute will provide lunch and snacks for all participants each day of the workshop.

do participants need their own equipment? NO. The Maysles Institute will provide participants with access to all necessary equipment.

what about field trips? There will be field trips. More details are provided at the beginning of the program.

how do I apply? Fill out the application, attach a stamp, and put it in the mail by April 15th. You can also fax completed applications to: 212.586.2057, or slip them under the door of the cinema at 343 Lenox Avenue.
